



## GLACIER COUNTY REGIONAL PORT AUTHORITY SUPPORTING SUCCESS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Glacier County Regional Port Authority will award two \$500 scholarships on an annual basis to individuals who reside in Glacier County and are graduating from Browning and Cut Bank High Schools. Scholarships are for school year 2023-24, to students planning on attending an accredited college, university, technical or trade school full time next year.

### SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Two awardees, one from each high school, will represent the Glacier County Regional Port Authority. Scholarships will show as credits on your college, university, technical or trade school bill. You must be planning to attend in the fall of 2023.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- **Scholarship Application:** Complete the application form in its entirety.
- **Essay Question:** Please read the following prompt and attach on a separate sheet. *How can your educational goals help you become a more informed citizen that can contribute to solving a current modern problem? Please use proper mechanics of writing, and have your essay proofread before sending. Finally, our board would like to "hear" what means the most to you, rather than what you perceive that others want to hear.*
- **One Letter of Recommendation:** Attach one letter from a teacher/coach, or from a personal reference, such as an employer, pastor, supervisor, etc. The letter must include the name, address, and telephone number of the person making the recommendation.
- **Current Transcript:** Please attach your current high school transcript. Your guidance counselor will provide this for you.
